Dear Admiral Zumwalt,

Over the years, members have suggested that the Society would be a legitimate and worthy beneficiary of a tax-deductible legacy in a will. As you know, bequests to a non-profit qualified organization, like our society, take many forms - such as outright legacies of money or stocks, which can be deducted from inheritance and estate taxes.

We have, I believe, managed the Society's resources with care and success. We have been able to publish "The French American Review", and we have provided support for exchanges of young scholars and students, and Franco-American events and initiatives. We still believe that the more effective way to expand our activities would be to establish the publication on a self-sustaining basis. Substantial bequests - such as those that provided our original resources - would be invaluable.
