Dear Admiral Zumwalt,


The Fiftieth Anniversary of the landing in Normandy will be celebrated this year, an occasion which carries a very special meaning for you.

In this respect the (A.S.F.L.H.) has decided to devote the 1994 Review to this remarkable event. Rather than formal historical accounts of this momentous event, we are seeking individual testimonies of those who lived through these trying and exalting days. We are therefore calling on you to recall your own experiences during the early days of the landing.

Could you provide us with a double spaced manuscript of 4 to 8 (maximum of 10) type written pages which we could subsequently edit. As well as a manuscript if you have personal photos or illustrations from this period suitable for reproduction.

The target date for delivery of this manuscript would be July 15, 1994. Our printing schedule would call for a publishing date of October 15 in time for the visit of the Grand Chancellor of the Legion of Honor.
