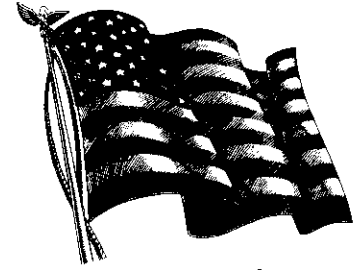


Sunday afternoon our annual parade will be held.
