<p>NOT TO BE RELEASED UNLESS CLEARED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE</p> <p>SUMMARY CONT</p> <p>THE U.S. AVIATION PLT, FIELD BASED AT KUSOK-TONG AREA APPROXIMATELY 135 KMS EAST OF SEOUL, KOREA, IN SUPPORT OF THEIR COUNTER INFILTRATION ACTIVITIES.</p> <p>ON 25 NOVEMBER, 1968, FIVE OF THE NORTH KOREAN INFILTRATORS WERE KILLED AND THEIR BODIES WERE BROUGHT TO THE ROK SPECIAL FORCES COMMAND POST IN THE KUSOK-TONG AREA. THEY WERE IDENTIFIED BY THEIR CLOTHING THE FOLLOWING DAY BY RELATIVES OF A SOUTH KOREAN FAMILY THAT HAD BEEN SLAIN BY THESE INFILTRATORS. LATER, ON THAT DATE, THE BODIES OF THE INFILTRATORS WERE TAKEN TO THE COUNTER ESPIONAGE OPERATIONS HEADQUARTERS, SEOUL, KOREA, BY 2½ TON ROK ARMY TRUCK.</p> <p>ACCORDING TO ROK ARMY INTELLIGENCE SOURCES, THE NORTH KOREAN INFILTRATORS TRAINED APPROXIMATELY 2½-3 YEARS, FOR THIS INFILTRATION MISSION. IT IS KNOWN THAT IN THEIR TRAINING, THEY CAN MOVE WITH FULL FIELD GEAR AND HAVE SAND FILLED INSIDE THEIR UNIFORMS TO AFFECT FURTHER ENDURANCE. THIS TYPE OF TRAINING ENABLES THEM TO MOVE AN AVERAGE OF EIGHT KILOMETERS PER HOUR IN THE RUGGED, MOUNTAIN TERRAIN OF SOUTH KOREA.</p> <p>TO THIS DATE, 51 NORTH KOREAN INFILTRATORS HAVE BEEN KILLED AND TWO HAVE BEEN TAKEN <del>AS</del> PRISONERS. APPROXIMATELY 5,000 ROK SOLDIERS, KOREAN NATIONAL POLICE AND HOME DEFENSE GROUPS ARE INVOLVED IN THIS MASSIVE MAN-HUNT.</p> <p>THESE OPERATIONS WERE COVERED IN EXTREME ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS AND TERRAIN.</p> <p>NOTE: THESE INFILTRATORS ARE MEMBERS OF THE 124TH NORTH KOREAN UNIT AS WERE THE 31 MAN RED COMMANDO TEAM WHICH MADE AN ABORTIVE ATTACK ON SEOUL, KOREA, 21 JANUARY, 1968.</p>
