SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report

1. (C) Opn Summary

a. Hqs: 042 flew 4 sorties for 5 hours of aerial recon along the Laos border. Provided 1 UH1H CAC aircraft for Bangart.

b. Troop A: Conducted first and last light for 3d Bde. Provided aerial recon to 3d Bde. Conducted VI via Hqs 101st ABN DIV. Conducted sniffer missions in Div AC. A/C remained at base in response to downed A/C. 042 received moderate AK47 fire via 045500 neg hit, engaged with gunships with unknown results.

c. Troop B: Conducted first and last light for 1st Bde. Provided aerial recon to 1st Bde. Conducted screening mission for Arty raid via Hqs 101st ABN DIV. Conducted insertions of 1 troop B radio relay to 16 on Hqs 101st ABN DIV, to 27 via YO 789959 and to 26 via YO 850934, all 12 were green. Conducted insertion of Ranger to Michigan, Ohio and Kentucky. During insertion of to Louisiana 1 UH1H conducted precautionary landing on LZ after blade strike. A/C was inserted and flown to Hqs 101st ABN DIV where it was rigged and brought to base by 0447. A/C remained at base in response to downed A/C.

d. Troop C: Conducted first and last light for 2d Bde. Conducted VI in Cav AC extension. Conducted Special sniffer mission within Cav AC extension. Conducted VI for contact mission for 1st 1-506 Inf. Conducted VI from Red Horse road with negative results. A/C remained at Hqs 101st ABN DIV for downed A/C.

e. Troop D: One platoon remained on standby as single reaction force. Inserted to 16 (to Hqs) via YO 762051, to 27 YO 789959 and to 26 via YO 850934. Maintains one radio relay car, 1 A/C and 2 ten man teams in Cav AC extension. One additional radio relay at Hqs 101st ABN DIV.
