SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report

1. (C) Ops Summary

- a. BRT: OTE flew 3/4 hours for 2 sorties of search area. OTE conducted subsequent IMA of TR 1400 and 1410. Provided 1 BRT in support of Troop B insertion and extraction.
- b. Troop A: Conducted first and last light 3/4 hrs. Provide aerial recon to Forward Bde. Conducted aerial recon of enemy activity. AHP remained at Quang Tri in response to downed A/C.
- c. Troop B: Conducted first and last light along 3/4 from HSB BRT to Bastogne and Katiya. Provided aerial recon to 1st Bde by conducting IMA of Army Road via 1st Bde. AHP was inserted via TO 67775 to conduct a BRT. AHP found footprints on trail belonging to 3 BVA personnel moving westerly within 12 hrs. Followed blood trail with negative results. AHP was extracted via TO 67775. AHP was green and returned to base where they remained for downed A/C. Provided 1st in escort to relief mission via TO 67775 with 2d Platoon Troop B. Provided escort to 1st from Birmingham to Bastogne. Provided VR for sensor activation via TO 67775.
- d. Troop C: Conducted first and last light along the Eagle - Pz Bde road 141. Conducted IMA in the Div AG. Conducted the Division sniffer in which the hot spots were turned into 2d Bde Artillery was employed with unknown results. Conducted Div VR Base. Conducted VR of Special VR Box via HSB O'Leary with negative results. Provided 3 BRT to Troop B in support of their AHP insertion and extraction. AHP remained at Pz Bde in response to downed A/C.
- e. Troop D: One platoon remained as Eagle reaction force. Provide 4 gun jeep escorts to and from HSB Vogel. Maintain one pl in the Div AG. Night location is TO 67779.
- f. Co L, 75th Inf: In 24/25 Vermont was extracted at 0704 hrs via TO 67775. He was green. Planned insertion in 22/23 Missouri. In night location

2. (C) Plan Summary

Troop A: Will conduct first and last light of action assigned by 1st Div. Will provide room to 3d Div as required. Will provide support to 1st Div in response to demand A/C. (AMP) on order. AMP will remain at 1st Div in response to demand A/C.

Troop B: Will conduct first and last light along 3d Div. Will provide support to 1st Div as required. AMP will be at 1st Div in response to demand A/C. Will conduct antitank in the Div A/C. Will remain in 1st Div.

Troop C: Will conduct first and last light along Eagle - 1st Div. Will support Troop D in Div A/C. AMP will be at 1st Div in response to demand A/C. Will insert 3d platoon Troop D and Ranger in Div A/C. Will extract 2d platoon and 3d platoon Troop D.

Troop D: One platoon will be AMP for Eagle. Will provide 4 gun jeeps escort to and from 1st Div. Will maintain one platoon in the Div A/C.

Co L, 75th Inf: Will maintain 4 tanks in Div A/C.
