a. Air Activity

(1) 242400H vic XD776237, A/2/17 obsr a double stream of approximately 100 tracer rounds at the point where route 616/S1 crosses the Vietnamese - Laotian border.

(2) 251235H vic XD967324, A/2/17 obsr footprints of 8 personnel moving north within the last 8-12 hours.

(3) 251240H vic XD979323, A/2/17 obsr 4 3x4' bunkers and 1 unoccupied AA/AW position with no signs of recent activity.

(4) 251243H vic XD987313, A/2/17 obsr 4-5 6x8' bunkers with signs of activity within the last 48 hours.

(5) 251245H vic XD986303, A/2/17 obsr 10 4x6' bunkers with signs of activity within the last 48 hours.

(6) 251130H vic XD991314, A/2/17 obsr 1 8x10' bunker with 8 4x6' bunkers surrounding the larger bunker with no signs of recent activity.

(7) 251140H vic XD995305, A/2/17 obsr 5 8x10' bunkers with signs of activity within the last 2-4 hours.

(8) 251152H vic YD013291, A/2/17 obsr a log and bamboo constructed garage, camouflaged, with no signs of recent activity.

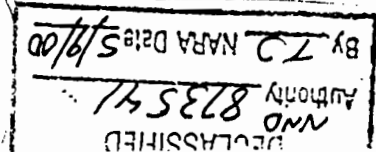
(9) 251157H vic YD021283, A/2/17 obsr a log and bamboo constructed garage, camouflaged, with no signs of recent activity.

(10) 251200H vic YD019285, A/2/17 obsr an unfinished road oriented N-S with signs of activity within the last month.

b. Ground Activity

(1) 250045H vic XD832430, Rgr tm LINCOLN observed 8 flashlights moving east on trail 20 meters to the west of their location.

(2) 242325H vic XD961315, D/2/17 heard movement by an unknown size enemy force 50 meters to their southeast. Results: Neg.

(3) 251240H vic XD962312, D/2/17 received 1 CHICOM grenade from an unknown size enemy force northwest of their position. The grenade did not detonate and the element immediately returned small arms fire, M-79 fire, and fragmentation grenades. Results: Unknown

(4) 251315H vic XD962312, D/2/17 received 1 RPG during extraction. Element returned small arms fire with unknown results. Results: Negative.
