SUBJ: JSC: Commander's Situation Report

1. (C) On 28 July

a. HHC: provided one UH1H for ranger G&C. Due to inclement nightfall mission on the 27 July was not flown. provided 1 UH1H for engineer team to be inserted via YC451921 to destroy a bridge.

b. Troop A: Conducted resupply of ranger radio relay team on hill 991. Conducted overflights with ranger for insertion of the Belgium and Bolivia. Supported ranger in the 2/17th Cav AO. Conducted extensive VR in Corp priority VR box. UH1A received intensive 12.7mm fire via XD965318, A/C crashed. The ARP was inserted via XD961518, 23 AK the LZ was green to secure A/C, which completely destroyed. The ARP was extracted via XD968314. It was red (hot). Results of crash 1 UE/KIA and 1 UE/VIA. UH1H via XD964308 received 15-20 rounds of 12.7mm MG fire. A/C sustained 1 hit in the fuel cell with no casualties. Engaged area with gunfire with unknown results. ARHG in support of downed LCH received 10-20 rounds of 7.62mm MG fire via XD968308, 1 hit in the engine cowling with negative casualties, A/C non-flyable. Engaged with gunfire with unknown results. Observed 1 MVA via XD965305 engaged with gunfire resulting in 1 MVA/KIA. (See LHM 209-70)

c. Troop B: ARP remained at Camp Eagle on standby for downed A/C. provided 1 UH1H in support of C 2/17th insertion of engineer team in the A Chum Valley to blow w bridge. Conducted first and last light VR of the Eagle. Timed Red rocket belt and FSB Homesteady Quick and ston. Conducted VR of contact of /F and CAP team via XD961505 for 28 Hrs. Conducted 3 selection for the extraction of ranger team: small caliber and outages.

d. Troop C: ARP was inserted via YC451926 across 10-20 from a bridge which was constructed of a log base with 6 pieces of 2x4 over the logs. Approx size of the bridge was 10' long, 180 inches wide. The top of the bridge was at water level. To the southern side of the bridge the ARP discovered 6 bunkers 4x4' and 9 fighting positions with no sign of recent activity. An engineer demo team from the 326 engineer placed charges on the bridge. The charges blew a hole 10' long, 6' wide,

6' deep destroying the bridge. ARF was extracted resulting in one bridge destroyed. Conducted VR of RE 11. (See INTCUM 209-70)

a. Troop B: provided gun jeep for convoy escort. provided one platoon for eagle IRF.

f. Co L, 75th Inf: Insertion planned for tomorrow the 24 Belgium and the 18 Bolivia. Extraction planned for tomorrow the 23 cutlars and the 14 Escalibor. Maintaining 4 teams in the Div A.C.

2. (C) Summary

Troop A: 1. A remain on standby for downed aircraft.
2. Conducted resupply of Ranger team on hill 950.
3. VR for 1st ARVN Box via XB 9754, 9749, 0149, 0154.
4. Conduct the insertion of the Belgium and to Bolivia.
5. Conduct VR of Box - Corp priority.

Troop B: 1. ARF will remain at eagle on standby for downed A/C.
2. Conduct first and last light of F B B-Block and Bortagne.
3. Provide direct support of 1st Bde.
4. Conduct survey of RE 11 that were created by dairy cutlars on 23 July 70.

Troop C: 1. ARF on standby at the Red for downed A/C.
2. Conduct first and last light of F B B-Block and Los Bamos.
3. Conduct the extraction of ranger in Escalibor and Cutlars.
4. Conduct VR in RE 11.

Troop D: 1. provide gun jeep escort for convoy.
2. provide one platoon for eagle IRF.

Co L 75th Inf: 1. Maintain 4 teams in the Div A.

3. (C) Teams of friendly & enemy locations: 1 U/AIA and 1 U/AIA.
b. Enemy: 1 U/AIA.

4. a. & b. No change.
c. Enemy external locations: UAV: 482 U/A, 5 U, 0 U/AIA, 0 U/AIA.
