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SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report

1. (C) Opn Summary

a. HHC: ONE flew 5 hours of aerial reconnaissance along the Leticia Border to the HHC. Provided 1 UH1H for transport of ranger team Belgium to G.F. Provided 1 UH1H for C&C for the insertion of the HAC BAD.

b. Troop A: ARB remained at G.F. in response to downed A/C, the rescue of hill 970 and for false insertions via P.B. atton. Conducted the insertion of the Belgium and the Bolivia. Conducted VR in special VR Box having Corp priority. Conducted VR of LS via XH76388 for the insertion of the HAC BAD. Conducted VR for B 1/XI Inf contact results were negative.

c. Troop B: ARB remained at Eagle on standby for downed A/C. Conducted first and last light VR of P.B. Birmingham and Bastogne and the special area Normandy to Leticia to Quick and the the Red rocket belt. Reported 1st Bde contact for 1/321 Inf. Conducted survey of LZ's that were created by AIR Force on the 28 Jul 70.

d. Troop C: ARB remained on standby at the Red for downed A/C. Conducted first and last light VR of P.B. Hank and Los Banzor. Conducted the extraction of ranger to Escaliber and Cutlass. Both VT's were green. Conducted VR of HHC II covering the A Shan Valley (see ITHUM 210-70) OTHA via YH262113 received AF neg hits engaged with gunship with unknown results.

e. Troop D: provide gun jeep for convoy escort. Provided one latrine for Eagle HHC.

f. Co L, 75th Inf: Conducted the insertion of the 24 Belgium via XH734406 and the 18 Bolivia via XH692442 both LS were green.
