SUBJECT: Operations Situation Report

a. H-1: Provided 1 UH-1 for observation.

b. Trip A: Provided 3 UH-1 to Subdard for possible insertion via landing. Provided pink team via ID 3012 for weather check. Area was unsuitable due to weather. Weather in secondary mission area is variable. The area via landing was unsuitable due to weather. 3 UH-1 plus 2 UH-1 from B 2/V were utilized to transport one person of B 2/V to Quang Tri. Weather began to clear in evening mission to be put on weather hold. Continued to make weather checks and general VI of the area. Mission for ground B-1 via Loutham cancelled 1400H with assets sent released to return to Camp Buehler. At 1700H had 1 AH-1 make a precautionary landing at ID 19374. H-1 was landed at 1700H. At 1720H A-1 on ground with rigging crew total 10 personnel. At 1730H a H-1 was requested. AH-1 out 1700H, 15 green. A-1 out at 1700H, 15 green, 10 H-1.

c. Trip B: Provided 2 UH-1 for transportation of B 2/V to Quang Tri. Provided pink team to investigate 7 H-1 reported in the open via ID 19374. Location of enemy in the open had negative results. Pink team would also make weather check in via of H-1. Could not work because of weather. Provided 1 UH-1 to C 2/V for weathering report. Provided pink team for A 2/V which had received incoming missions via ID 19374 with negative results. At via ID 19374 pink team located abandoned mortar position. Provided pink team for 3-4 AH-1 via ID 19374. At 1700H observed 1 H-1 in basket via ID 19374. Engaged with gunships resulting in 1 H-1 down. At 1700H observed 1 H-1 via ID 19374, ID 19374, and ID 19374 with neg hits. Engaged with gunships with unknown results. At 1700H B 2/V released to return to Camp Buehler. Provided 1 UH-1 to transport rigging crew from H-1 to Camp Buehler to rig C 2/V H-1. Provided 1 pink team for report by 4/3 AH-1 for H-1 in open, neg results. Completed H-1's off 1400H & 1400H with results compiled and summarized to G-2 Air. Provided last light of sunset bolt. Provided 1 UH-1 for extraction of C 2/V H-1. Provided 1 pink team for 1st AH-1 for estimated 2 H-1 companies in the open. Results unknown and closing log.

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d. Trip C: Provided first light H-1 and A-1, Trenchant and 1st

Demob. Provided 2 UH1H for pickup of Engineer team at Borneo. Provided 1 UH1H and 1 A1H for longer overflight. A UH1H picking up engineers at Borneo had a black smoke and went down as it was taking off. Accident investigation initiated. Issued 4 UH1H for Borneo to provide guards for downed aircraft and pickup Engineer team and return to Pna. Provided one UH1H to coordinate with HHC and supply situation via HHC. Provided one UH1H for transportation of accident board to Borneo. Utilized 1 UH1H from 2 2/7 and 2 UH1H from 0 2/7 for wheeling project. At 1700H began moving 0 2/7 ARP into LS via HHC 7507G. At 1715H completed first lift into IS - 10 personnel LS green. At 1700H 6 Engineers had been inserted same location, IS was green. At 1715H observed 2 HVA with radio and AR-15's via HHC 7507G. Engaged with HHC 7507G in 2 HVA/KIA. At 1730H 0 2/7 ARP observed 2 HVA. Engaged with 1 HVA/KIA and 1 HVA/VIA. Provided 4 UH1H to pickup 15 personnel 2 2/7 & 3 Engineers for body search. At 1745H body search was complete with equipment returned to Camp Eagle to 2/7 HHC. At 1750H 0 2/7 UH1H was extracted from Camp Borneo to 5th Force, Pna. At 1800H 0 2/7 ARP & 325 Engineers were extracted.

a. Trip B. Provided gun jump escort for 21 HHC. Provided one platform for standby of 2 2/7 ARP at Camp Borneo. Provided 12 personnel for security of body search mission.

f. Co L. Overflight conducted 0700H for future insertions. Provided 3 personnel for body search at IS 7407G at 1715H. Personnel were extracted at 1715H with body search results.
