SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report

a. HHC: Provided 1 UH1H to transport msg advisers LHO to HHC. Provided 1 UH1H to insert msg in Tampa.

b. A TRP: Provided Pak Tn and CAC via Barbara for insertion of Huc Bae and employ A/S. Provided 4 UH1H for insertion of Huc Bae LE gun at 1030, YN99360 145 commenced. At 1145 Huc Bae found 5 NVA/KH YN902563 they had been killed approx 12 hours early. At 1320 Huc Bae found 1 NVA/KH, 1 AK47, 1 pack, 1 explosive, documents and markings on uniforms indicate 3rd Co LHO Sapper Battalion.

c. B TRP: Provided 2 Pak Tn to QT to support Huc Bae operations. Provided 1 Pak Tn via G'Reilly. At 0705H OH6A rec'd 7.62mm fire via YN517223 with msg/hits. Msg with g/s w/unk/res. At 0735H OH6A rec'd EAF via YN527224 with msg/hits. Msg w/g/s with 1 NVA/KH. At 0740H OH6A rec'd SAF via YN527224 with msg/hits, msg w/g/s w/unk/res. At 1225H provided a Pak Tn & UH1H to check YN514222 for suspected enemy loc. HHC's were not completed due to weather. At 1714 Huc Bae and msg advisers extracted YN94754 PZ gun.

d. C TRP: Provided 1 UH1H and 1 AH1G for msg overflight. Provided a Hvy Pak Tn, CAC, 4 UH1H for the insertion of in Tampa 5 personnel and 25 personnel D Trp at YN803826 HZ gun. At 1700 UH1H made a precautionary landing at FUB Veghel. At 1845 UH1H was sling out.

e. D TRP: Provided 1 Latcon HDP Eagle. At 1435 provided 25 personnel via YN803826 to conduct night ambush.

f. Co L: Maintained 3 tin in southern AO. Conduct overflight for insertion of Tampa. At 1435 tin Tampa was inserted with 25 personnel D Trp YN803826 LE gun. Radio relay was moved from Veghel to Pental.

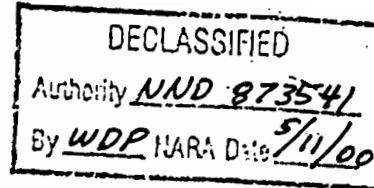
