- (3) 091535H vic YD620111, B TRP obs 12 2'x2' fighting psns w/act 24 hrs.
- (4) 091540H vic YD620111, B TRP AMIG recd minor shrapne, damage at 1000' and 100kn from unk source.
- (5) 091548H vic YD623112, B TRP obs 3' wide trail, oriented NW-SE, w/act 24 hrs.
