1. MISSION: Conduct area recon to determine nature and extent of enemy activity in the area. Select ambush sites to identify NVA elements operating in the area of interest. To attempt FOW snatch if the tactical situation permits.
2. EEI: Id, size, and activity of enemy in the area.
3. SIZE/COLPOSITION: 6 US.
4. CONDITION OF PATROL: Go d.
5. INSERTION/EXTRACTION:
 - a. IN: 031007H via YD328145 Method: Touchdown.
 - b. OUT: 101343H via YD327158 Method: Ladder.
6. ROUTE: See para # 8.
7. TERRAIN:
 - a. Canopy: Double.

8. ENEMY: Vic YD326145 Tm came upon a trail, 2' wide. Tm followed trail for next two days. Trees along trail had "V" shaped markings pointed E and three horizontal cuts. Vic YD327145 Tm found sleeping posns and a 4'x6' bunker w/ overhead cover connected to an 8'x6' mortar psn. Neg rec act in the area. CINI on the 3rd vic YD323146. Vic YD333147 Tm obs a tree which had a trail junction marked on it and the number "21". It also had the three horizontal cuts and arrows pointing both ways down the trail. At same loc Tm found one 3'x6' bunker. Vic YD332152 Tm found two bunkers and 4 graves. Neg rec act in the area. CINI on the 4th vic YD332152. On the 5th tm found steps cuts into the trail and vines used as handrails, w/act 1 week. CINI vic YD327160. At 060200H Tm heard several explosions of unk origin at YD327160. Vic YD328158 Tm discovered remains of two campfires, one inside a cave w/act 24 hrs. CINI on 6th vic YD327159. At 071400H vic YD327106 Tm obs 3 NVA 20m to their E. The NVA were two boys, 14 to 16 yrs old and one older man. They were moving S down the middle of the river carrying 2 AK-47's, 1 RPD and rucksacks and were wearing green fatigues and sandals. Did not engage due to lack of commo. Vic YD327158 Tm obs tracks in a bomb crater w/act 1 week. CINI on 7th vic YD327158. For the next 3 days Tm stayed at same loc. They heard voices and trees being chopped down at YD325161 during the daylight hours all three days. At 081645 Tm heard 1 shot, SSW 75m to s. At 101130H Tm heard 1 shot, SSW 75m to W.
9. NATURAL WATER SOURCES: Vic YD329153 to YD327160 Tm obs 3 to 4 streams, 10' to 25' wide and 1' to 4' deep.
10. COMMUNICATIONS: Good except down by river.
11. HAZZ's: Negative.
12. CONCLUSIONS: There is a base camp of some size under construction in the area.
