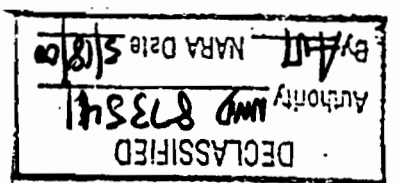

On the 13th Tm mov E to hill 432 vic YD460006. Tm believed to have been followed. Tm stayed in area and act as radio relay. Tm experienced difficulties w/commo and ONH vic YD460006. On 14th Tm mov at 1130H to YD469008 where they obs 12' wide trail oriented SE-NW w/signs of 1 personnel mov SE-NW w/act 24 hrs. At 1500H vic YD456012 Tm set up OP. Tm obs 7 fighting psn, 1 steel pot. vic YD456011. Tm unable to monitor road due to heavy ground fog. ONH VIC YD456012. On the 15th Tm obs 6 NVA/VC mov S-N on 547 vic YD455015. NVA/VC were mov about 15 m apart. Tm remained in area due to heavy ground fog. At 1330H Tm mov to YD455013 and obs 2 bunkers size 8x10' in good condition. Tm tried to mov to road, unable to do so because the ridge was too steep. At YD454609 Tm obs 2 NVA/VC and made contact. Tm extracted w/out further sighting or observations.
