1. (U) 2/17th Cavalry INTTELUM 78-71
2. (U) 182000H to 192000H March 1971
3. (U) Summary of enemy activity

a. Air Activity:

- (1) 191000H vic YD495837 to YD27C096, B Trp obs signs of hvy foot traffic from Ashau strip to Turnage. Act 12 hrs b est 5 veh of undet size.
- (2) 191030H vic YD301049, B Trp obs 20-25 mounds of rocks. The pile ranged from 2x2' to 8x8' in size. Act 12 hrs.
- (3) 191045H vic YD420965, B Trp obs signs of hvy foot traffic on a 3' wide trail oriented E-W to 547 w/act 12 hrs.
- (4) 191500H vic YD289101, B Trp obs from Aloui to Hskin numerous tra and bunkers and bridges. Bridges were covered w/PSP. Trp also obs 300m long PSP strip. Eng/bridge w/gc. Res: 1 bridge damaged. Act in area 12-24 hrs.
- (5) 191530H vic YD304077, B Trp UNH CGC recd 40-50 rds 12.7mm and 30-40 rds SA7, neg hits. Damage w/out res. Contacted PAC.

b. Ground Activity:

- (1) 19130H vic YD45109755, Rgt Tm Fayetteville found 1 RIG rd w/2-3 inches above ground. The rd is believed to be booby trap. Neg rec act.
- (2) 191516H vic YD495057, Rgt Tm Medicine Hat found est 3 pairs of sandals, 1 rice bowl, 2 NVA canteens, 3 10 ad clips of AK ammo, 1 belt buckle w/st 1 6" dia trip flare, 1 NVA steel pot w/liner, 1 pancho, 1 tooth brush, and 1 tube of tooth paste. All articles were found in a ravine.
