- (1) 260830H vic YD718148, B TRP obs and picked up 2 AK-47 magazines w/6 rds in a rice bag in a small pit. Act 24 hrs.
 - (a) 261230H vic YD276093, B TRP obs an undet number of truck and veh tracks. Act 24 hrs.
 - (3) 261210H vic YD232088, B TRP obs 25 bunkers along N side of Rt 512. Camouflaged w/ent, 2'x3' w/act 24 hrs.
 - (4) 261250H vic YD228093, 38 YD239121, B TRP obs 15 newly const fighting pns 3'x5' along road w/foot prints last 6 to 12 hrs. No veh tracks on road.
 - (5) 261300H vic YD302089, B TRP obs bulldozer act last 24 to 48 hrs, and rock mounds previously obs have been leveled. Rock mound at YD301088, 6'x6'x5'.

 (23) 261750H vic YD452014, B TRP obs where truck had pulled off road, pos unloading pt. Act 24 hrs.
 (2) 261755H vic YD452014, B TRP obs where truck and bulldozer have been clearing shoulder of road. Also obs barrels in stream bed. Act 48 hrs.
 (25) 261800H vic YC442970, B TRP obs 2 fighting pns, 1 1/2'x3'x4' w/act 24 hrs.

- (1) 260130H vic YC466934, Rtr Tm PIMTSBURG heard truck moving S on Rte 547 2000m to N of Tm psn. St obs about every 30 sec and then over on.
 (2) 260240H vic YC484875, Rtr Tm INDIANAPOLIS obs 2 3/4 ton trucks heavily loaded and running w/lights on. Moving S on Rte 547, 50m to NE of Tm.

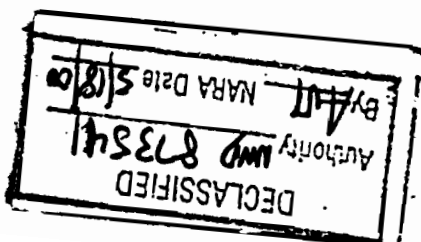

MISSION: Monitor Rte 548 to determine extent of enemy activity in the area.

1. Select ambush sites to identify NVA elements in the area of interest.

2. EEL: Identity, size and activity of enemy in the area.

3. SIZE/COMPOSITION: 5 US.

4. CONDITION OF PATROL: 1 US KIA, 1 US minor scrapnal wounds in hand.

5. INSERTION/EXTRACTION:

OUT: 260921H vic YC484875 Method: Touchdown.

6. ROUTE: See para # 8.

7. TERRAIN:

a. Canopy: None.

b. Vegetation: Elephant grass.

c. Undergrowth: Very thick.

8. ENEMY: ONH on 23rd vic YC478874. ONH on 24th vic YC482876. Vic YC481876, Tm found 1 hut, 10'x20'x6' w/cooking area and misc cooking utensils. Also 2 bunkers, 8'x10'x3' w/3' o/c, bamboo floors and reinforced. Area used by est squad sized unit within last 2 wks. There were 3 trails, 1' wide, in the area. One went W 70m to a partially completed bunker, 8'x10'x3'. Another went N to a bomb crater full of water. The third went SE to a latrine, 1'x3'x2' w/wood cover. A fourth trail led to the stream to NE. It was 3' wide and had overhead concealment consisting of elephant grass held 4' over the trail. It showed signs of heavy use within the last week. ONH on 25th vic YC484875. At 260200H Rgr Tm 19-A called in trucks headed S. At 260230H INDIANAPOLIS heard the same trucks. There were two pos 3/4 ton. They had heavy loads because they had difficulty climbing a small hill. They had gas engines and drove with fog lights. At 0830H Tm obs 5NVA moving from NE to S across stream. They wore black shorts and shorts, pith helmets and no web gear. They had at least 2 AK-47's and 1 RPD. The NVA crossed stream and Tm engaged and killed point man at 2'. Second man in the element carrying an RPD fired a burst, wounding 1 Tm member in upper back and one in the hand. Tm engaged the second NVA and obs his body in water on other side of stream. Tm was exiled at 0921H.

9. NATURAL WATER SOURCES: Negative.

10. COMMUNICATIONS: Good.

11. HLZ's: Could touchdown nearly anywhere.

12. CONCLUSIONS: NVA could have been either a pt element or just a river sweep.
