A 2/17: Provided Cav Tm coverage in a screening mission for 3rd Bde. Provided Cav Tm VR coverage in Recon Zones 4 & 5. Other missions were not accomplished due to inclement weather in their A O. At 1205H Vic XD 898516 A Tm observed one NVA wearing a green uniform with helmet and pack, engaged resulting in one NVA KIA. At 1230H A Tm observed one NVA wearing a green uniform with helmet and pack Vic XD 914551, engaged resulting in one NVA KIA. At 1430 Hours an AH-1C Vic XD 872302 rec'd 2 hits SAF, aircraft flyable-
engagement due to undetermined location of fire.

B 2/17: Conducted last light of Eagle Perimeter. Other missions were not accomplished due to inclement weather in their A O.

C 2/17: Assigned missions were not accomplished due to inclement weather in the A O.

D 2/17: Maintained 2 platoons on standby for IRF. Provided one Platoon on standby for Eagle Reaction Force.
