Subject: Guerrilla's Situation report

HH: Provided 2 HH aircraft in support of 3 2/17. Provided 1 CAC and remaining aircraft on standby.

A 2/17: Dispatched 11 of all seven zones 2 thru 7 with emphasis placed on CAC and Vietnamese Soldiers. Remained on standby for downed aircraft. Was unable to report to command due to priority of missions. At 140000 CAC took 15 min, 30 Cal Vio 10 00000, engaged with unknown results. CAC 0004 mentioned two figures. At 141000, observed and engaged, 1 FVA & 2 30' x 30' huts Vio 10 00000, resulting in 1 FVA KIA & 2 huts destroyed. At 141500 HH observed and engaged 2-30 FVA in green uniforms and numerous tents, pits, and huts, resulting in 6 FVA KIA. The air and HH also engaged resulting in 9 huts, 9 15 x 15' pits, 1 bunker 4'x8' & 2 dugouts each 4'x4' destroyed.

B 2/17: Provided CAC on V coverage in support of 1st BCo and HH base insertion. Provided HF from 141000 to 141800. A/P remained at Eagle in response to downed aircraft. Observed last light of Eagle Paratrooper. At 141500 HH, HH took 5 min 12.7 and Vio TC 20000, no hits sustained.

C 2/17: Provided CAC on V coverage in support of 1st BCo and HH base insertion. A/P remained at the HH in case to do and aircraft. Observed last light of Eagle Paratrooper. At 140800 while supporting 1st BCo CAC took 40 min Vio TC 20000. Engagements sustained. Engaged 1 FVA with unknown results.

D 2/17: Troop units were on standby for reinforcement in ground operations. Provided 1 platoon on standby Eagle location force.

1 HH mission to contact ground reconnaissance in 0 was completed on limited basis. (9 men were inserted and extracted with HH base).

HH base conducted ground operations under 1st BCo. Insertions completed 2007 HH. 1 2 ground, extraction completed 1607 HH condition red.
