Commander's Situation Report

HH: Provided a slick on standby status. Also provided a UH1H as a GAG aircraft, flown by Col. Rider, who expended approximately 4 fuel loads in the area of the 2/502 Bn. insertion.

A 2/17: Provided 6 heavy Pink Teams with Chase for an operation involving the 338th ARVN Marines in the Vic 0334. Also employed 10 airstrikes in the Vic YD 002301. BNA's revealed 4 NVA KBAF, 2 NVA KBH, 2 bunkers destroyed, and 2 bunkers damaged.

- 1) AH1H rec'd 5-10 rds SAF Vic YD 006295, neg hits, engaged g/s with unknown results.
- 2) OH6A rec'd 10-20 rds SAF Vic YD 006295, neg hits, engaged g/s with unknown results.
- 3) Observed 1 NVA Vic YD 009294, engaged with A/S results, 1 NVA KBAF.
- 4) Observed 5 NVA Vic YD 001301, engaged with A/S results, 2 NVA KBH, 3 NVA KBAF.

B 2/17: Provided 5 heavy Pink Teams with Chase in support of the 2/502 operation. Also, 1 GAG UH1H was provided for the operation. 1 Pink Team worked the southern part of A Chau Valley with Col Rider Vic A Chau Strip. 1 UH1H was used for Ranger over flights. Last light of Eagle Perimeter was also completed.

- 1) OH6A rec'd 6 rds SAF Vic YD 341111, engaged g/s with unknown results.
- 2) OH6A rec'd 8 rds SAF Vic YD 341111, engaged g/s with unknown results.
- 3) OH6A rec'd 8 rds SAF Vic YD 335107, engaged g/s with unknown results.
- 4) OH6A rec'd 1 rds SAF Vic YD 335107, engaged g/s with unknown results.
- 5) Observed 5 NVA and 1 2½ ton truck Vic YD 305081, engaged g/s with 2 NVA KBH and 1 2½ ton truck destroyed.

C 2/17: Provided 4 heavy Pink Teams with Chase in support of 2/502 operations. Also 2 GAG UH1H aircraft were provided to the 2/502 operation. 2 fuel loads were expended by OH6A's during convoy cover. Last light check of the Eagle/Fin and Rocket Belt was complete.

- 1) OH6A rec'd 30 rds SAF Vic YD 298127, neg hits, engaged g/s and A/S with unknown results.
- 2) OH6A rec'd 15-20 rds 12.7 Vic YD 319086, possible 1 hit; engaged g/s with unknown results.
- 3) Observed 1 NVA KBAF, 1 2½ ton truck destroyed by A/S.
