HMF: Provided 1 UH1H for standby as CAG, also provided 1 UH1H to pick up 1 person at A 2/17 location and transport him to Camp Eagle.

A 2/17: Reconned a special VR box south of F B Shiloh with heavy Pink Team and Chase ships. 3 fuel loads were expended here. A heavy Pink Team and Chase conducted a VI of 616 west of Tan Teyern. A second team conducted a NDA of targets west of Tan Teyern.

- 1) NDA of A/S Vio D 974289, 7 bunkers destroyed, 6-8 bunkers damaged, 1 NVA KBAP.
- 2) NDA of A/S Vio YD 073283 reveals 1 NVA KBAP.
- 3) NDA of A/S Vio YD 102202 reveals 2 bunkers, 1 motor destroyed.
- 4) NDA of A/S Vio YD 095204 reveals 6 bunkers, 2 hootches destroyed, 2 NVA KBAP.
- 5) Observed old AA/AN and 1 8"x10" bunker Vio YD 102202, engaged g/s, 1 bunker dest.
- 6) Observed 2 huts, 6 bunkers, 6 pits and boxes Vio YD 095299, engaged with g/s air-strikes, 1 hootch and 4 boxes destroyed by A/S, 1 hut destroyed by Caw. 1 secondary explosion.

7) At 1540 hrs Vio YD 095204, observed a 18"x20" hut with green canvas roof, also observed 3 storage sites with bamboo cover. Contents were 15-20 boxes of possible small arms; the boxes were 5' long, 1' wide and covered with black plastic, 2 sets of Khaki uniforms, 2 sets of black pajamas, 1 white shirt, 2 red shorts and 6, 2"x4" bunkers in the area. The size of the holes are 10"x20"x6".

B 2/17: Reconned VI zones 4, 5 and 6 with 3 heavy Pink Teams and Chase, but due to bad weather, they were unable to complete their mission. A UH1H proceeded to FCB Pepper to fire artillery in that location, but due to engine breakdown, was unable to work. IFF status was maintained until 281600 hrs. Last light Eagle Perimeter check completed.

- 1) Reports 2 active 12.7 Cal Vio YC 592953, unable to engage due to weather.
- HMF:** These weapons are approximately 1 K from 2 known 23mm positions.
- 2) YC 459905, 4 pieces of P-P used as bridge just East of a bridge recently destroyed by Rangers.

C 2/17: Reconned zones 7, 8 and 9 with 2 heavy Pink Teams and Chase. 1 team expended 1 fuel load in support of 2d Bde. A UH1H was used for training of C 2/17 pilots. A OH6A was provided for convey escort. Last light of the Eagle-Pan Bai Rocket Belt was complete. IFF for C 2/17 will begin at 281800 hrs until 291800 hrs.
