Subject: Commander's Situation Report

RR: Provided C&C at 0730.

A 2/17: Provided support for extraction of 369th ARVN, vicinity Patton. Conducted BDA of 1 Arc light. Was unable to BDA rest due to weather. 1 team with Chase was dispatched to VR in A0, but returned to base because of weather.

B 2/17: Conducted detailed VR of suspected pipeline. Provided 1 team to accompany Cliff 54 into A0. Conducted VR of zone 7 east of 64 grid line. Supported Ranger insertion and extraction of 1 person. Provided IRF from 071800 to 061800 hrs. Conducted last light VR of Eagle Perimeter.

C 2/17: Provided support of 54th ARVN as briefed. Provided Pink team on station vicinity Co Pang in support of 1st Bde. Provided IRF starting 081800. Conduct VR of Hae Rocket Belt.

D 2/17: Provided Eagle Reaction Force.

L 2/17: Maintained 3 Ranger teams in field. Conducted extraction of sick Ranger and insertion of replacement.

2. Utilize TAC AIR on suspected pipeline. Join with Trail FAC over destiny at 1145 hrs Peggy frequencies.  
3. Prepare to insert ARP for comm line tap as directed, and weather permits. Target time for takeoff will be announced.  
4. IRF on standby 081800-091800.  
5. Eagle last light perimeter check after 1830.

C 2/17: 1. Support 54th ARVN move, via Bradley with Cav team. On station at 1300 hrs. Prior 54 AME on 61.65.  
2. VR, early, suspected Binh Tran location at vic YD 4192 and trails leading into this position and west side of valley. From Aloui south. Report best airstrike targets for 1201 hrs.  
3. Cav team on call for Cliff 54, to employ airstrikes, and cover for insertion of B 2/17 ARP in valley.  
4. IRF on standby 091800-101800.  
5. Hae Rocket Belt screen after 1830 hrs.

D 2/17: 1. Eagle Reaction Force.  
2. Troop on 45 minute standby to react to Bravo ARP insertion.
