(C) The following areas are submitted in priority order for visual reconnaissance by the 2d Squadron, 17th Cavalry on 14 July 1971. Essential elements of information are provided for each area.

1. Route 608 extension with emphasis on the new road running north between KD7730 and KD7760. To determine the extent of enemy traffic on the road and the status of the road. To determine the extent of enemy traffic on the new road and current construction efforts. To locate the northernmost point on the new road and to determine enemy efforts to connect the new road to other roads/trails in the area.

2. Routes 922 and 9222. To determine the status of the roads and the extent of enemy traffic on the roads. To determine the status of the interdiction points on the roads.

3. The Da Krong Valley between PB Nink and PB Tam Tavern. To determine the extent of enemy activity in the valley and to locate enemy bases and supply areas.

4. Route 616 between VI and 47 and the new road running north from Rte 616 between KD77300 and KD91294 with emphasis on the area in the vicinity of KD917343. To determine the extent of enemy foot and vehicular traffic on Rte 616 and to determine the status of the interdiction points. To determine the extent of enemy activity on the new road and to locate enemy attempts to connect the road. To locate points at which the new road can be effectively interdicted and to locate enemy bases/caches along the new road.
