Admin/log mission were completed.

- A 2/17: Provided a heavy Pink Team with Chase to complete a VR Vic AR 90-30-30. Pink/Chase Teams VR'd RT 616. VR's of RT 3 were conducted by two heavy Pink Teams with Chase. One OH6A flew an admin/log mission along with the UH1H's. IRF on standby status.
- (1) A 2/17 observed 15-20 ammo boxes, rocket boxes Vic XD 919413, engaged with G/S results; 2 secondary, 1 fire.
 - (2) A 2/17 observed 1 NVA Vic XD 983321 engaged with G/S results; 2 NVA KBL.
 - (3) A 2/17 OH6A rec'd 40 rds AF Vic YD 053327 engaged with G/S results; 2 NVA KBL.
 - (4) A 2/17 engaged SEL with G/S Vic YD 140405 results; 5 NVA KBL.
- B 2/17: Provided two Pink Teams and a heavy Pink Team with Chase to support an ARVN operation Vic PSB Huts. Three UH1H's were provided for standby IRF in case of downed aircraft on Seaboard Pad at Eagle. A heavy Pink Team with Chase conducted a VR of RT 5. Last light was completed by a White Team for a VR of the Hue/Bay of Tan My Rocket Belt. Five aircraft were test flown, four OH6A's and one AH1G. Three UH1H's and one OH6A completed admin/log missions. IRF on standby status 261800 to 271800.
- C 2/17: Provided two Pink Teams with Chase and three heavy Pink/Chase Teams in support of an ARVN operation Vic PSB Huts. Two additional heavy Pink Teams with Chase also supported the ARVN operation, making a total of five heavy Pink/Chase and two Pink/Chase Teams. Three UH1H's were supplied for standby IRF, at Seaboard, Camp Eagle in case of downed aircraft. Two aircraft, one OH6A and one AH1G were test flown. Last light VR of Hue/Bay of Tan My Rocket Belt was completed by a Pink Team. Two OH6A's and one UH1H completed admin/log missions.
- (1) C 2/17 OH6A rec'd 200 rds SAF Vic YC 755771, observed 5 NVA engaged with G/S results; 1 NVA KBL.
 - (2) C 2/17 OH6A rec'd 100 SAF and 40 rd 12.7 Vic YC 7774 engaged with G/S and AF results; 1x 12.7 destroyed.
 - (3) C 2/17 observed 2 NVA gr in uniforms with webb gear Vic YC 76699 engaged G/S results; 2 NVA KBL.
- D 2/17: Completed early morning "sweep" of B sector, Eagle perimeter. Two platoons were on 5 minute standby IRF on Seaboard Pad Eagle as a Reaction Force in case of downed aircraft. Maintained Eagle Reaction Force.
- I. Co: Maintained contact with four Ranger Teams in the field. Two teams were inserted today, but there were no extractions. The names of those teams in the field are (a) Mary (b) Jo Ann (c) Pam (d) Bonnie. Other teams required for future operations.
