(a) The following areas are submitted in priority order for visual reconnaissance by the 2d Squadron, 17th Cavalry on 2 August 1971. Essential elements of information and indication of recent enemy activity are provided for each area.

a. Route 608 extension. To determine the status of the routes and to locate suitable interdiction on the route. To determine the extent and type of traffic on the route and to locate elements of the 45th NVA Arty Regt (Collateral location for the 45th Arty Regt. and signs of road repair/construction on the Greene-Alpine road. Supplies and ammunition observed on 1 August.)

b. Red Devil Road with emphasis on the draws north and south of the road. To determine the extent of traffic along the road and to locate suitable interdiction points. To locate elements of the 9th NVA Regiment. (2 URS's on 1 Aug and collateral location of the 9th Regt.)

c. A Shau Valley in the vicinity of FB Fury. To determine the extent of enemy traffic on route 548. To locate suitable interdiction points and elements of the 6th NVA Regiment. (3 URS's and 3 sensor activations in 2 days).
