(C) The following areas are submitted in priority order for visual reconnaissance by the 2d Squadron, 17th Cavalry on 3 August 1971. Essential elements of information and indication of recent enemy activity are provided for each area.

a. Route 608 extension. To determine the status of the routes and to locate suitable interdiction on the route. To determine the extent and type of traffic on the route and to locate elements of the 45th NVA Arty Regt (Collateral location for the 45th Arty Regt. and signs of road repair/construction on the Greene-Alpine road. Supplies and ammunition observed on 1 August.)

b. A Shau Valley between FB Rendezvous to Route 922 with emphasis on grid YD 444933. To determine the extent of enemy traffic on the Route and to locate elements of the 6th NVA Regiment. To locate a possible rice transfer point at the stated grid. (Collateral location of elements of the 6th NVA Regiment. 3 sensor activations and suspected rice transfer point on 2 Aug). ~~2 Aug~~

B ~~Reconnaissance~~ Routes 922 and 9222. To determine the status of the interdiction points and to determine the extent of enemy traffic on the routes. To locate elements of the 6th IVA Regiment. (Recent reports of heavy route and AA/AW activity in the area. Road repair work and signs of truck traffic on 2 Aug. 2 URS's in the vicinity on 2 Aug).
