(C) The following areas are submitted in priority order for visual reconnaissance by the 2d Squadron, 17th Cavalry on 6 August 1971. Essential elements of information and indications of recent enemy activity are provided for each area.

a. Da Krung River Valley between FB Shepherd and FB Tun Tavern. To determine the extent, direction and type of enemy trail/stream activity in the area. To locate elements/bases of the 66th NVA Regiment. To determine the status of the road north from FB Tun Tavern. (Base area discovered on 2 Aug. Heavy URS activity for 30 days. Road construction activity for 8 days.)

b. The Ruong Ruong Valley between FB Fist and FB Pistol and Route 545. To determine the extent of enemy activity in the area and to locate elements of the 4th NVA Regiment. To determine the extent of enemy traffic on Route 545 and to locate points at which the route is interdicted. (Collateral location of the 4th NVA Regiment.)

c. Ba Long Valley between FB Holcomb and FB Sarge. To determine the extent of enemy activity in the area and the extent and type of traffic on Route 556. To locate suitable locations for implanting sensor strings. (Primary avenue of approach from Western Quang Tri (P) to Hai Lang (D)).
