(G) The following areas are submitted in priority order for visual reconnaissance by the 2d Squadron, 17th Cavalry on 8 August 1971. Essential elements of information and indications of recent enemy activity are provided for each area.

A a. Da Krong River Valley between FB Shepherd to FB Shiloh. To determine the extent, type and direction of enemy trail/road/stream activity. To locate areas suitable for sensor implants and to determine the status of the road running north from Tan Tavan. To locate elements of the 66th and 812th NVA Regiments. (Suspected base area discovered 2 Aug. Heavy URS activity for 30 days and collateral location of the NVA Regiments. Heavy ground-to-air fire on 7 August.)

A b. Route 606 extension. To determine the status of the route and to locate suitable interdiction points along the route. To determine the extent and type of traffic. To locate elements of the 45th NVA Artillery Regiment. (Supplies and ammunition observed in the area within last seven days. Road construction and signs of traffic on Greene-Alpine road.)

B c. A Shan Valley between Ta Bat Airstrip and the Laotian border and the area south of FB Thor. To determine the direction and extent of traffic on Rte 548. To determine the extent of enemy activity south of FB Thor. To locate elements of the 6th NVA Regiment. (Collateral location of 6th Regiment. Signs of truck traffic for over a week. Two URS's and one incident of ground-to-fire on 7 Aug.
