(b) The following areas are submitted in priority order for visual reconnaissance on 20 August 1973. Important Elements of Information and indications of recent enemy activity are provided for each item.

5-241 Copy

(1) The southern A Shau Valley area with emphasis on the area bounded by FB Kompanie, FB Bandervous, Eagle's Nest and FB Vogel. To locate elements/units of the 6th PVA Regiment. To determine the status of Routes 548 and 547 in the region area. To determine the extent and direction of enemy movements in the area. (Suspected enemy offensive preparations in the area)

(2) The ~~Rung~~ ~~Rung~~ Valley area between FB Rifle and FB First and west to FB Huts. To locate elements/cohorts/signs of the 4th and 7th NVA Regiments. To determine the type and direction of enemy traffic in the area. (Signs of vehicular traffic and ABP readings in the area.)

b. 3-5 Gray

(1) QL-9 between the Iaotian Border and YB Sarge and the Ba Long Valley between YB Sarge and YB Hoakmer. To locate elements of the 52B and 812th NVA Regiments. To determine the type and direction of enemy traffic in the area. (Four A/CRF and indications of track traffic on QL-9 on 19 August)

(2) Area west of a line from YB Sarge and YB Fuller and the area northwest of YB Fuller. To locate elements of 52B NVA Regiment and firing positions used for ABP on Fuller, Mud, Da Ho, and Sarge. To determine the extent and direction
