(U) The following arms are submitted in priority order for visual reconnaissance on 20 August 1974. Essential Elements of Information and indications of recent enemy activity are provided for each item.

2-11 CAV

(1) The southern & Shan Valley area with emphasis on the area bounded by FB Tamu Pass, FB Handervous, Eagle's Nest and FB Veghal. To locate elements/ caches of the 6th NVA Regiment. To determine the status of Routes 548 and 547 in the recon area. To determine the extent and direction of enemy movements in the area. (Suspected enemy offensive preparations in the area)

(2) The Ruong Bui Valley area between FB Rifle and FB First and report to FB Bns. To locate elements/caches/signs of the 4th and 7th NVA Regiments. To determine the type and direction of enemy traffic in the area. (Signs of vehicular traffic and ABP readings in the area)

b. 3-5 day

(1) QL-9 between the Laotian Border and PB Sarge and the Ba Long Valley between PB Sarge and PB Hooker. To locate elements of the 32B and 812th NVA Regiments. To determine the type and direction of enemy traffic in the area. (Four A/GRF and indications of track traffic on QL-9 on 19 August)

(2) Area west of a line from FB Sarge and FB Fuller and the area northwest of FB Fuller. To locate elements of 52B NVA Regiment and firing positions used for ARF on Fuller, Nui Ba Ho, and Sarge. To determine the extent and direction
