## Brigadier General Teddy G. Allen

Chief, Joint United States Military Advisory Group,  
Philippines

Brigadier General Teddy Allen was born in Farmville, North Carolina on 19 May 1936. Upon completion of the Reserve Officers Training Corps curriculum and the educational course of study at North Carolina State University he was commissioned a second lieutenant and awarded a Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture. He also holds a Master of Arts degree in education from George Washington University. His military education includes completion of the Infantry School, the Aviation School, the United States Army Command and General Staff College, and the Air War College.

He has held a wide variety of important command and staff positions culminating in his current assignment as Chief, Joint United States Military Assistance Group, Philippines. Other key assignments held recently include Deputy Post Commander, and later, Aviation Group Commander, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), Fort Campbell, Kentucky, and Chief, Aviation Division, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations, United States Army Forces Command, Fort McPherson, Georgia.

General Allen served in a variety of important career building assignments preparatory to his most recent duties. As a company grade officer, he served in various leadership positions in an infantry battalion attached to the United States Army Armor School. After attending flight school, he was assigned to the Aviation Company of the 3d Armored Cavalry Regiment, United States Army Europe. In 1966, he was sent to Vietnam and served as an Aviator with the 1st Aviation Brigade. Following this tour, he was assigned to the United States Army Aviation School element at Fort Stewart, Georgia and served successively as a Training Officer, Operations Officer in a Composite Aviation Battalion, and Company Commander in an Aviation Support Company. During this period, he was detailed to Vietnam to assist in the



redeployment of the 9th Infantry Division Aviation Company. In 1971 he was reassigned to Vietnam, where he served as an Aviation Company Commander and Cavalry Troop Commander with the 101st Airborne Division (Airmobile). After an assignment as an Enlisted Personnel Distribution Officer with the United States Army Military Personnel Center in Alexandria, Virginia, he rejoined the 101st Airborne Division, now at Fort Campbell, Kentucky. With the Division he served as the Aviation Group's Executive Officer and later as an Aviation Battalion Commander.

Awards and decorations which General Allen has received include the Silver Star, the Distinguished Flying Cross (with three Oak Leaf Clusters), the Bronze Star Medal (with two Oak Leaf Clusters), the Meritorious Service Medal (with two Oak Leaf Clusters), various Air Medals, the Army Commendation Medal, the Expert Infantryman Badge, the Master Army Aviator Badge, and the Air Assault Badge.

He is married to the former Mari Lynn (Lynn) Paulhus. They have four children: David, Elizabeth, Cynthia, and Christopher.
