Reds Down Helicopter; Two Killed

SAIGON, Viet Nam (UPI)—Communist guerrillas today shot down a U.S. Army turbojet helicopter in the jungled mountains of central Viet Nam, killing two Americans and wounding two others, a U.S. military spokesman said.

It was the second fatal crash of a U.S. Army helicopter in South Viet Nam, in as many days and raised the two day toll to six Americans killed and two wounded.

The new deaths raised to 243 the number of American servicemen who have died in South Viet Nam since January, 1961.

The American spokesman said the HU1 turbojet helicopter was shot down by Viet Cong Communist guerrillas this morning some five miles east of Hiep Duc in Quang Tin province, about 340 miles northeast of Saigon.

The dead were one officer and one enlisted man, the spokesman said.

The helicopter crashed on the jungle-covered slope of a 1,000-foot high mountain in the rugged area of central Viet Nam.
