AWARD OF THE AIR MEDAL FOR HEROISM
TC 439. The following AWARD is announced.

JACKSON, JAMES T. [REDACTED] WARRANT OFFICER (WO1) UNITED STATES ARMY
Battary F 79th Artillary

Awarded: Air Medal with V Device

Date of Action: 16 April 1972

Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Authority: By direction of the President, under the provisions of Executive Order 9158, 11 May 1942, as amended by Executive Order 9242-A, 11 September 1942, and DA Message 979888, dated 29 July 1964.

Reason: For heroism while participating in aerial flight in the Republic of Vietnam. Warrant Officer James T. Jackson distinguished himself by heroism in aerial flight on 16 April 1972. Disregarding his own safety, he courageously exposed himself to the dangers inherent in aerial flight as he directed his efforts toward neutralizing the enemy threat. His heroic and valiant actions contributed materially to the successful accomplishment of the United States mission in the Republic of Vietnam and were characterized by a great concern for the welfare of his comrades. His heroic actions are in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit and the United States Army.
