SUBJECT: Lieutenant Colonel Command Designees for FY 1984

1. Reference: Message, DAPC-OPA, 131800Z August 1982, subject: FY 84 Lieutenant Colonel Level Command Selection Boards.

2. General.

a. Department of the Army Selection Boards, convened at the direction of the Chief of Staff of the Army to consider lieutenant colonels and promotable majors for designation as commanders qualified for assignment to lieutenant colonel command designated positions during FY 84, met as follows:

(1) Combat Arms Command Board convened 16 November 1982 and adjourned 9 December 1982.

(2) Combat Support Arms Command Board convened 30 November 1982 and adjourned 13 December 1982.

(3) Combat Service Support Command Board convened 16 November 1982 and adjourned 9 December 1982.

b. Board membership and the letters of instruction furnished to each board by the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel are at Inclosures 1 through 4. The administrative instructions, guidance, and eligibility criteria, which were common to all boards, are at Inclosures 5 through 7. The list of officers selected for command, listed alphabetically within each category is at Inclosure 8. Officers deferred from FY 83 command, who were revalidated, are included.

3. Summary of Board Actions.

a. Number of officers designated as principal command designees for FY 84 are shown below:

Discrepancies between the above numbers and those stated in the LOIs are a result of changes which occurred after adjournment of the boards.

b. The overall selection rate was 5.0% based on the total number of officers eligible for consideration and the number selected to fill projected FY 84 vacancies.

4. Instructions on Use of Lists. These lists are intended to inform commanders and officers concerned of the names of lieutenant colonels and promotable majors selected for command designated positions. The US Army Military Personnel Center, with the concurrence of major

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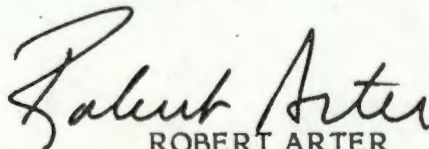

commanders, will assign officers whose names appear on these lists against appropriate FY 84 command designated position vacancies.

5. Removal from Command Lists. The Commander, US Army Military Personnel Center, may temporarily defer an officer for cause, based upon a request from the officer's chain of command or the receipt of information for any of the following reasons: relief for cause, substandard performance of duty, or questionable moral or ethical standards. Each year the regularly scheduled command selection boards will review the records of all deferred officers and forward all recommendations for removal from command designated status to the Chief of Staff, Army for approval. Commanders should ensure that grounds for removal are promptly brought to the attention of the Commander, US Army Military Personnel Center.

6. Alternate Command Designees. Department of the Army Boards designated an adequate number of alternate command designees to ensure the availability of qualified lieutenant colonels to provide for exigencies, such as unprogrammed additions to vacancy lists and unexpected attrition to the list of principal selectees due to declinations, deferrals, or removals. The names of alternate command designees are not listed in this letter. Alternate command designees will be notified by their commanders and by individual letter of their status. In the event they are needed for assignment to command designated position vacancies, the same policies governing principal command designees will apply. The FY 84 Lieutenant Colonel alternate command designee lists will remain in effect until Chief of Staff, Army, approval of the FY 85 command selection lists. Alternates who have not been activated for command prior to the convening of the FY 85 Lieutenant Colonel command selection boards will be considered by the appropriate board(s), along with all other eligible officers, as long as they meet the eligibility criteria.

7. Slates. The proposed slates for each major command have been forwarded to the commanders concerned for their review. Once the US Army Military Personnel Center has received concurrence from all the major commands, the selected officers will be notified of the command for which they are slated by the MACOM to which they will be assigned. This notification process will take place within 60 days from the date of this letter.
