

2	0800		<p>(1) At approximately 0800 hrs, a work crew from the main PA&E came to the hospital to replace the existing water pump and breaker box at the pumping station. PA&E did not coordinate their actions with the personnel at the 24th Evacuation Hospital. The electricians failed to accomplish their tasks and consequently, the water pump was not working and the main water tank was not being replenished, resulting in a total loss of water at 1100 hrs. Electricity was restored at 1130 hrs.</p> <p>(2) 24th Evacuation Hospital PA&E began work on a work order requiring them to replace the pipes to the mess hall and nursing quarters. (All water to the hospital had to be cut off). Instead of replacing the pipe branching from the main mess hall line, they just capped it and ceased working. The hospital proper and male latrines were therefore out of water, since this was the pipe that fed water to these areas. PA&E was asked to send out an emergency crew to correct the error. Water was restored at approximately 1930 hrs.</p>						GR

2	0200		Long Binh Post received rocket and mortar fire. LBP went on Red Alert. The Emergency Room started receiving casualties shortly thereafter. Within the first 5 hour period, the hospital recorded approximately 50 admissions. Among these admissions were COL Edmund Castle, LBP Commander, and MAJ Christian Lampe, HHC, LBP. Seven casualties were DOA. The entire staff of doctors and nurses were to be commended for their performance during this situation. During this 24 hours period, over 70 patients were admitted, most of them requiring surgery. At approximately 0700, the Operating Room had a 12 hour backlog of patients. A backlog continued in the Operating Room until approximately 2200 hrs.		GR
