Circular Letter to Member Governments

Excellency:

I have been directed by the Executive Committee of the Indo-Pacific Fisheries Council to draw your attention to a recommendation made by the Council at its last meeting that the Secretariat should be responsible for the reception, reduction and publication of water temperature data collected by the Member Governments, and should issue these in some form of atlas. As a preliminary to implementation of this recommendation, it is requested that Member Governments furnish the Secretariat with statements of the series of temperature observations which are being taken at present under its auspices, and advise the Secretariat of the steps which they would propose to take to furnish the Secretariat regularly with the data obtained in the course of these observations.
