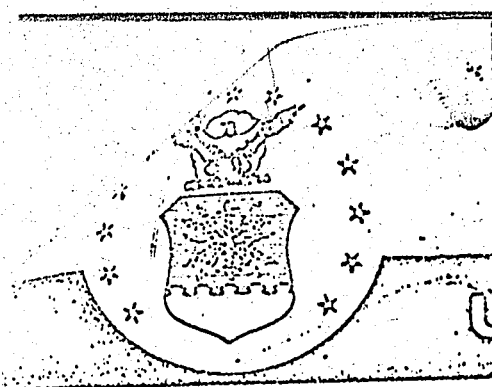

CHAPLAIN (COLONEL) RAYMOND E. TINSLEY

Colonel Raymond E. Tinsley is the Base Chaplain at Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska.

Colonel Tinsley was born in Flat-Lick, Kentucky, October 15, 1921. He joined the Army Air Force in 1942. From 1947 to 1952 he was in Inactive Reserve. He attended officers candidate school in Miami, Florida and was commissioned in 1943. He was a resident student at Squadron Officers School in 1954 and attended Command and Staff School in 1961 and the Air War College in 1968.

Chaplain Tinsley attended Livingston College, Salisbury, N. C. and Kentucky State College, Frankfort, Kentucky from 1941 through 1949 interspersed with a tour in the military during World War II. He was graduated in economics from Livingston College in 1949.

Colonel Tinsley attended the Hood Theological Seminary in Salisbury, N. C. and was graduated in 1951. The chaplain's denomination is the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church.

Chaplain Tinsley received a masters degree from New Mexico State University in counseling training in 1960 and later received a second masters degree in social science at Sacramento, California in 1968. He is presently working on his Ph. D. in Adult and Continuing Education at the University of Nebraska in Lincoln.

Colonel Tinsley has served at Itazuke Air Base, Japan, 1954-57; Whiteman AFB, Mo., 1957-58; Biggs AFB, Tex., 1958-60; Thule AFB, Greenland 1960-61; Mather AFB, Calif., 1961-66 and Spangdelham AFB, Germany.

Prior to being assigned to Offutt AFB, Chaplain Tinsley was with the 49th Tactical Fighter Wing Spangdelham, Germany.
