PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION: Establishment of Tuyen Duc Province
in the P.M.S.

FIELD REPORT NO. FS - 3126

According to Mr. Chu ngoc Lien, Deputy Prefect of Dalat, President Ngo dinh Diem issued a decree at the beginning of May, ordering the establishment of Tuyen Duc Province which includes:

1. Dalat Prefecture actual limits
2. Dran District actual limits including Fyan and Ankroet.

The Dalat Prefecture will then follow the same regulations as now.

The Dalat Prefect will also assume the charge as Province Chief of Tuyen Duc.

Plans for the organization of the new Province are under way and further information will be sent in as soon as obtained.

NEW PROVINCE CREATED IN HIGHLANDS

Saigon.- (VP) May 23

The President of the Republic recently signed an order providing for the establishment in the Highlands, Central area, of a new province named Tuyen-Duc. The administrative headquarters of the new province are located at Dalat.

Tuyêñ-Duc province includes:

- 1) the territory of the Prefecture of Dalat,
- 2) the territory of the Dran district, which will be separated from Lam-Dong province.

The Prefect of Dalat will also be the chief of Tuyen-Duc province, which lies within the fourth military region.
