

ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF COMMISSARIAT GENERAL FOR AGRICULTURAL LAND DEVELOPMENT.

The recently created Commissariat General for Agricultural Land Development includes the following organizations:

- I.- Secretariat
- II.- Directions and Internal Services
- III.- Centres

Secretariat

The Secretariat is managed by a Director of Cabinet assisted by a private Secretary, two Chargés de Mission and two Attachés of Bureau.

The Secretariat includes:

- a) a Secretariat
- b) a private Secretariat
- c) an External Relations and Security Section

Directions And Services

A.- Direction Of Administrative Affairs: placed under the orders of two Chiefs of Service: Service General of Administrative Affairs and Personnel Service.

B.- Direction Of Finances: led by a Director assisted by two Chiefs of Service: the Accountancy and Budget Service, and the Supply and Transportations Service.

C.- Transfers and Resettlement Direction: led by a Director assisted by two Chiefs of Service: the Transfers and Resettlement Service and the Control and Statistics Service.

D.- Plantation Service: this service directly depends on the Director of Cabinet and led by a Chief of Service.

Centres

The Centres directly depend on the Commissariat General for Colonization. Each centre is led by a manager assisted by an assistant.

Each centre can embody one or several provinces.

Technical Direction

The Technical Direction is under a Director assisted by a number of experts. This Direction includes two services:

- Service of Agricultural Development
- Service of Plan.

National Office Of Exploitation and Mechanical
Agricultural Equipment

This Service, endowed with legal capacity and financial autonomy, is led by a Board of Directors. Its management is assured by a manager.

Inspection Of Administrative, Financial and
Technical Affairs

The Inspection of Administrative, Financial and Technical Affairs, directly depending on the Vice-President of the Republic is led by an Inspection General, assisted by an Inspector.
