After one month in Cleveland I have got a job as Cashier in Kaiser Foundation on August 11. I am proud to present your attestation as well as those of Dr. Wesley Fishel, Dr. Guy Fox, Mr. Sanderson, Mrs. McKee etc. as my references.

My wife and my children are very happy in resettlement in the United States. Three of my children are students of the Cuyahoga Community College, the other two are students of Lakewood High School, just beside of my house.

In general, my family is presently pretty well resettled. We received a lot of assistances from the International Rescue Committee (IRC) and from many of the American living in our quarters specially my sponsor. You see, we left Vietnam just 2 days before the April fall of Saigon government with very few clothing on hand, nothing else.
