1. MR. TRUONG VINH LE WAS BORN IN SOCTRANG, SOUTH VIET-NAM, MAY 13, 1914. HE IS A MEMBER OF THE PERSONALIST COMMUNITY AND HAS PREVIOUSLY TRAVELED IN THE UNITED STATES. HE HAS SOME KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH. MR. LE IS PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF VIET-NAM, HAS A SCHOLARLY BENT, AND IS ESPECIALLY INTERESTED IN OBSERVATION OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND POLITICAL PARTIES' ORGANIZATION AND FUNCTIONING.

2. MRS. NGUYEN THI XUAN LAN WAS BORN IN DALAT, CENTRAL VIET-NAM, DECEMBER 7, 1932. SHE HAS AN EXCELLENT KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH. SHE IS ESPECIALLY INTERESTED IN EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES AND HOPES TO VISIT NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINE OFFICES AS WELL AS UNIVERSITIES. SHE IS A MEMBER OF THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE.

3. MRS. PHAN THI NGUYET MINH, WHO STUDIED IN THE UNITED STATES, IS ALSO KNOWN AS PAULINE THO. SHE WAS BORN IN GLADINH, SOUTH VIET-NAM, FEBRUARY 2, 1929. A MEMBER OF THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE, SHE IS INTERESTED IN THE FORMULATION OF FOREIGN POLICY AND IN THE TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY. SHE SPEAKS FLUENT ENGLISH.

4. MR. CO VAN HAI WAS BORN IN DINH TUONG, SOUTH VIET-NAM, SEPTEMBER 22, 1918. HE IS CHAIRMAN OF THE AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, PRESIDENT OF THE SOCIALIST ALLIANCE, AND SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE VIET-NAM SOCIALIST PARTY. HE IS ESPECIALLY INTERESTED IN ASPECTS OF AGRICULTURE AND INDUSTRY. MR. HAI HAS SOME KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH.

5. MR. PHAM DUY LAN WAS BORN IN HANOI, NORTH VIET-NAM, ON OCTOBER 15, 1923. HE IS DEPUTY SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AND FIRST VICE PRESIDENT OF THE SOCIALIST ALLIANCE. HE IS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COMMITTEE. HIS SPECIAL INTERESTS INCLUDE THE MANUFACTURE AND UTILIZATION OF AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS AND ROAD-BUILDING EQUIPMENT, THE OBSERVATION OF TRADE UNIONS AND SOCIAL WELFARE ORGANIZATIONS, AND THE LIFE OF TYPICAL FARMERS AND INDUSTRIAL WORKERS. HE KNOWS SOME ENGLISH.

6. DR. TRAN SY DON WAS BORN IN VINH, CENTRAL VIET-NAM, APRIL 24, 1928. A MEDICAL DOCTOR, HE IS A MEMBER OF THE CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL, AND YOUTH COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, AND IS A FORMER CHAIRMAN OF THE DEFENSE COMMITTEE. HE IS ESPECIALLY INTERESTED IN EDUCATION AND MEDICAL EDUCATION AND IN HOSPITALS AND MEDICAL RESEARCH CENTERS. HE KNOWS SOME ENGLISH.
