AT THE MEETING ORGANIZED TO HONOR THE TWO GIRLS OF
THE REPUBLICAN YOUTH OF PHUOC TUY MURDERED
BY THE VIET CONG

It is with the deepest feeling that, in the name of the Solidarity Movement of the Vietnamese Women, I bow before the souls of our Sisters Ut and Ban to present to their families the condolences of the Women of Viet Nam, to manifest (indestructible) solidarity with our dear departed ones and to express the profound indignation which rouses the Vietnamese Women against this ignoble and cowardly crime perpetrated by the Viet Cong traitors.

Hidden behind the great names of Resistance and Welfare of the country, the Viet Cong have already cynically exploited the sacrifices and the victory of the whole people to the sole profit of their Party and their Russian and Chinese Communist masters. Now, camouflaged under the label "Liberation of South Vietnam" they are again trying to dupe the people, to foment civil strife, to provoke an exodus of Vietnamese citizens to Cambodia -- always in pursuit of their dirty and bloody work of treason and their dark schemes to retard the progress of our people.

The savage murder of the young girls of Phuoc Tuy lays bare the true and sinister face of the Viet Cong and exposes them as the band of brigands they are, a mafia of evil-doers and cowards, a gang of cynical traitors.

Cowardly they shoot women and young girls in the back hoping in this way to demoralize us and cause us to desert the historical ~~movement~~ National movement of which we are the avant-garde. But they are fooling themselves if they think that we are as cowardly as they. The women of Viet Nam will teach them a good lesson, so they will understand that in attacking us they can only make us more determined to destroy them as they deserve to be destroyed.

Dear Sisters, Ut and Ban! You leave us: but your spirit lives on in the thoughts and the hearts of all the Women of Viet Nam.

We shall never forget you who meet death or who are maimed for life because you wished to express your solidarity with us in coming, with no hesitation to travel the long distance, to bring your youthful presence to the Vietnamese Women's Day Celebration organized by the women of the Capital. We shall always remember that you shed your blood in the shadow of the flag of the Republican Youth, symbol of the courage and the determination with which the Vietnamese Youth are reconstructing the country -- never retreating one step in the face of any intimidation whatsoever.

We, the Women of Viet Nam, shall never betray your memory.

The Nursery for Children of Consumptive Persons opened on Saturday morning at No. 227, Cong Quynh street, Saigon, at a ceremony with Madame Ngo Dinh Nhu presiding.

"This is clear evidence," she said, "that women in Vietnamese society are particularly aware of others' sufferings and never fail, when the occasion arises, to give proof of their generosity and charity."

She said she is convinced that, as a result of substantial support from the government, charitable organizations and private individuals, the association will bring into being "more undertakings of such a remarkable and humanitarian nature as this one."

Madame Ngo Dinh Nhu wished that the "generous action" being carried out by VAWP will help relieve destitute people.
