Implementation of Agrarian Reform Report

A number of the recommendations contained in the Agrarian Reform Report (listed below) were of general applicability, or if in reference to the agrarian reform program, would be useful regardless of the eventual form which the program will take. Could we take action to get started on these?

1. Study of fees charged for government services to see whether they meet the cost of performing the service.
2. Study of land transfer procedures and fees.
3. Acceleration of land survey and land registration program.
4. Obtaining copies of land transfer records now held in France.
5. Planning the acquisition of new equipment for the cadastral service.
6. Establishment of management reporting programs.
