On 2 December I flew to New York in connection with some work I had undertaken as a consultant to the Ford Foundation, and to visit with officials of business and banking concerns in New York and in Washington, DC regarding problems of professional training and education.

The visit with Ford Foundation officials was satisfactorily completed. I spoke with ranking personnel in the Standard Vacuum Oil Co at White Plains, the First National City Bank of New York, the Research Institute of America, and the Asia Society, among others.
