Dear Dr. Bailey:

We are very pleased that you and the American Council on Education are going to be coordinating our efforts to assist in expediting the evacuation of Vietnamese intellectuals.

Attached is a list of more than 80 such individuals, with addresses, telephone numbers where available (accuracy of those numbers is probable, but not guaranteed), and, wherever possible, an indication of professional nature or affiliation of the individual. Virtually all have wives and children and in a few instances these have been individually listed by name. I have tried to avoid duplications, but since these data are coming in from diverse sources, this is not always possible. I assume your organization or the Department of State will check this.

In calling scholars around the country, I have asked them to write directly to you with information, and would assume you will be hearing from them very soon. I shall have a second list to forward to you within a very few days.

If there are other ways in which my colleagues and I can assist in this effort, do not hesitate to call upon us.
