SUBJECT VISIT OF VICE RECTOR DANG

THE VICE RECTOR IS CURRENTLY IN CHICAGO VISITING THE PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION SERVICE AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS LOCATED IN THE BUILDING AT 1313 EAST 60TH STREET. HE TELEPHONED OUR OFFICE ON TUESDAY, MAY 9, AND SEEMED WELL-SATISFIED WITH THE ARRANGEMENTS MADE FOR HIM IN CHICAGO AND ADVISED THAT HE WOULD ARRIVE BY TRAIN AT 3 P.M. ON SATURDAY, MAY 13. HE WILL VISIT THE DORSEYS THAT EVENING AND THE FISHELS ON SUNDAY. IN FACT, HE WILL BE WELL TAKEN CARE OF NEARLY EVERY EVENING HE IS IN EAST LANSING.

SEVERAL APPOINTMENTS HAVE BEEN SET UP FOR DURING THE WEEK DAYS ON CAMPUS WITH SUCH PERSONS AS MR. BRANDSTATTER, MR. MILTON TAYLOR, ET AL. WE HAVE HELD UP MAKING TOO MANY SUCH APPOINTMENTS UNTIL THE VICE RECTOR ARRIVES SO THAT WE MAY DETERMINE EXACTLY WHOM AND WHAT HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE AND DO. IF HE WISHES, WE SHALL MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR HIM TO VISIT GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN THE STATE CAPITOL, FOR EXAMPLE, AND PERHAPS A TOUR OF OLDSMOBILE.

THE PRESENT ITINERARY CALLS FOR MR. DANG TO DEPART BY TRAIN FROM EAST LANSING ON MAY 22 AND GO DIRECTLY TO BOSTON. WE HAVE ALERTED SEVERAL PEOPLE IN THE BOSTON AREA, BUT, AGAIN, WISH TO CONFIRM WITH MR. DANG JUST WHICH ONES HE HAS PARTICULAR INTEREST IN SEEING. ALL PARTICIPANTS HAVE BEEN ADVISED THE DATE THEIR VICE RECTOR WILL BE IN THEIR RESPECTIVE AREAS. WE HOPE TO HAVE MR. KY VISIT EAST LANSING AND ASKED MISS KIM SA WHETHER SHE WOULD BE ABLE TO MAKE THE TRIP UP, BUT SHE INFORMED US HER EXAMINATION SCHEDULE AT THAT PARTICULAR TIME WOULD PRECLUDE HER LEAVING INDIANA.

A PROFESSOR BEBOUT AT RUTGERS UNIVERSITY, WHOSE ASSISTANCE WE SOLICITED AT THE SUGGESTION OF PROFESSOR CHARLES ADRIAN, IS MAKING ARRANGEMENTS FOR MR. DANG TO VISIT THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THE DIRECTOR AND COMPTROLLER OF THE DIVISION OF BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING, AND THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF TAXATION IN TRENTON, NEW JERSEY.

AS I BELIEVE YOU ALREADY KNOW, MR. DANG WILL ATTEND THE WORLD CONFERENCE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IN WASHINGTON THE WEEK OF JUNE 13. WE ALSO HAVE ARRANGED FOR HIM TO MEET WITH SOME OF THE STAFF MEMBERS OF BROOKINGS INSTITUTION WHILE HE IS IN THAT AREA.

WE HAVE WRITTEN TO RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA, WITH REGARD TO A VISIT THERE, BUT HAVE NOT AS YET RECEIVED A REPLY TO OUR LETTER.
