

SUBJECT: TVA Field Trip

We will be travelling in a 34 passenger University bus. There will be sufficient room for storage of luggage. It will be a long trip but we will make frequent rest stops on the way, and the uncrowded condition of the bus will provide sufficient leg room.

Travelling with the group will be Sansullah Kirmani, Pakistan; Zarina Nazir, Pakistan; Roderick MacDonald, Scotland; and Edward Bailey, United States.

16 December 8:00 AM Depart for TVA. Bus will be on the West side of the Union. We will travel all day with frequent rest stops. Our overnight stop will be at the Hotel Miami, Dayton, Ohio. The necessary reservations have been made. You will have the evening free for your own relaxation.

17 December 8:00 AM Depart for TVA. Bus will pick you up at the main entrance of the hotel unless you are notified otherwise. Travel all day with frequent rest stops. We will stay at the Kingston Pike Hotel for our period of stay in Knoxville where TVA headquarters are located. You will have the evening free.

18 December 8:30 AM Assemble for bus trip to TVA headquarters.

9:00 AM Assemble in TVA Conference Room, New Sprinkle Bldg. View the films, "Valley of the Tennessee." and "This is TVA".

10:00 AM Discussion of the overall work of TVA by a representative of the General Manager's office. Question period.

11:30 AM Lunch

12:30 PM Field trip to visit Kingston Steam Plant (largest in the world) and Fort Loudon Dam (located on the Tennessee River downstream from Knoxville; has power plant and navigation lock). A TVA staff member will be on the bus to guide and assist the group.

5:30 PM Return to Hotel. The evening is free.

19 December 8:30 AM Assemble for trip to TVA headquarters.

9:00 AM Assemble in conference room. The time from 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM will permit discussion and question period of the following two aspects of TVA's operation: personnel and public administration, and agriculture.

Field trip to a test demonstration farm. The trip can include a stop at another dam - a different type from the Fort London dam. A representative of the TVA Division of Agricultural Relations will accompany the group.
