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PREFACE

. This bibliography brings together a selection of materials on the political and administrative history of Vietnam from the Nguyễn Dynasty, whose date of origin is usually given as 1802, to the present time. A limited number of items on the history before the 19th century and on the general history of Vietnam have been included for background purposes. Since it was impossible to properly survey the relevant materials, developments in the Democratic Republic of Vietnam since 1954 have for the most part been excluded.

The work seeks to provide the student with a basic orientation to materials in the French, English and Vietnamese languages. For works in Chinese the reader should consult the listings under the bibliographical section. The compiler has purposely refrained from critical remarks about items included.

Entries have been selected on the basis of their importance, authoritativeness, and appropriateness to the subject. Only a small number of legal and juridical works have been included though most of the material published on public administration in Vietnam is of this type. In his search for an understanding of the dynamics of government

and administration in Vietnam the student must turn to the abundant historical literature. For this reason almost half the work is devoted to historical materials. An important place has been given to economic and social conditions in the belief that political science and public administration can best be studied in the context of the total environmental setting.

The reader's attention is directed to the fact that Vietnamese names usually consist of three words--with the family name given first and the familiar name last. In accordance with most frequent Vietnamese practice, entries by Vietnamese authors are inverted with the familiar name given first. Writings in romanized Vietnamese, "quốc ngữ," begin to appear in quantity after 1915. Standardization, and adaptation to modern technical usage, is a continuing problem.

The 964 entries included in the bibliography were screened from some 3,500 annotated titles. The collection was actually begun at Paris in 1953, where the resources of the Bibliothèque Nationale, the libraries of the École Française d'Outre-Mer, Faculté de Droit, and the Institut des Études Politiques of the University of Paris were readily available. The work was continued in Saigon during 1954-1956. In the United States the compiler made use of

the resources of Harvard and Yale Universities during the academic year 1959-1960; and of the Library of Congress during the summer of 1961, when he benefited from a grant for that purpose from the American Council of Learned Societies and the Social Science Research Council.

The assembling and final annotations were completed in Saigon during February-May 1962, as a part of the Michigan State University Group project. The support and encouragement of Dr. Guy Fox, Chief Advisor to this project, as well as that of his entire staff, is gratefully acknowledged.

Special recognition is also given to Mr. Phạm Huy Thủy and the staff of the Thư Viện Viện Khảo Cổ (Library of the Institute of Historical Research), Mr. Nguyễn Hùng Cường and the staff of the Tổng Thư Viện (General Library) and to the personnel at the Thư Viện Quốc Gia (National Library), the Thư Viện Học Viện Quốc Gia Hành Chánh (Library of the National Institute of Administration), and the library of the "Société des Études Indochinoises." In Washington at the Library of Congress Mr. Cecil Hobbs gave generously of his time.

My colleagues on the project, Miss Thu-Nga and Mr. Bổng, deserve special praise. Mr. Hoàng Văn Lượng is thanked for typing the manuscript.

A survey from antiquity to 1900, with a summary and chronology for the period 1900-1957.

A short summary by a French Sinologist.

9. Chastel, G. Un Siècle d'Épopée Française en Indochine, 1774-1884. Paris, Éditions de l'École et Collège, 1948. Pp. 205.

A survey of French activities and intervention.

Comments upon major personalities and events from the time of Monseigneur d'Adran and Emperor Gia Long to that of Commandant Rivière.

Emphasizes what are considered to be psychological errors made by the French in their dealings with the Vietnamese.

Based upon an archeological survey made 1934-1939.

20. Khôi, Lê Thành. Le Vietnam--Histoire et Civilisation. Paris, Ed. de Minuit, 1955. Pp. 587, bibl.

A survey from antiquity to 1953. Includes chronology of names and events. Based upon French, Vietnamese, and Chinese sources. Stresses the economic factor in history.

21. Kiêm, Thái Văn. Đất Việt Trời Nam (The Vietnamese Land and Sky). Saigon, Nguồn Sống, 1960. Pp. 603.

A survey of the history, geography, and culture.

A summary history with a description of present governmental and cultural institutions. Also published in French.

23. Kim, Trần Trọng. Việt Nam Sử Lược (Brief History of Vietnam). Hanoi, Tân Việt, 1951. Pp. 587.

A survey from antiquity to 1900. Based upon Chinese, Vietnamese, and French sources. Reviewed by Gaspardone, BEFEO, 30(1930), 431-432.

24. Ký, Trương Vĩnh. "Souvenirs Historiques sur Saigon et Ses Environs," (1-32) in Excursions et Reconnaissances, Vol. X. Saigon, Imp. Coloniale, 1885.

Traces history from 1680 when Saigon was said to be a Cambodian village.

Charles B. Maybon has added an introduction and notes to this history, first published in 1810.

Treats various events and experiences in Vietnamese history from antiquity. On the failure of the Yên Bái revolt, for example, the author blames: Excessive patriotism and hence the lack of foresight; faulty planning; poor organization; and the lack of a base for a long resistance action.

A survey from antiquity to 1947.

The author uses Chinese language sources.

The author was named head of the mission in Tonkin in 1658. A primary account of the period.

Relates to trips to "Tonkin en Inde par le Yunnan et le Canton."

Deals with Fou-Nan ("en gros Cochinchine et Cambodge") during the first half of the third century. This and other works by the great French Sinologist are basic to the early history of Indochina.

A general survey with a focus on conditions in the 18th century. Vol. 2 is devoted to political and religious topics.

Vietnam is treated, 60-263.

This work was begun in the 14th century by a Vietnamese refugee in China. The translation is of a reprint of a Japanese version published in 1884. The copy is said to be incomplete and to contain errors.

The account of a British seaman who was captured and afterwards crossed the country on foot.

Impressions by the son of J. B. Chaigneau (Consul de France at Huê and French mandarin in the service of the Vietnamese Emperor).

73. Chên, Lê Đình. Cuộc Đời Oanh Liệt của Tả Quân Lê Văn Duyệt (The Glorious Life of Lê Văn Duyệt). Saigon, Phổ Thông, 1956. Pp. 106, bibl.

Biography of a high mandarin who was active during the reign of Nguyễn Anh (Gia Long).

Translation of the original document is by Hoàng Yên.

Treats the activities of J. B. Chaigneau. Based on materials from the French Ministries of Foreign Affairs, and Marine and Colonies.

A contemporary survey of the land, people and institutions. Also includes sketch of Vietnamese history to the 19th century.

77. Crawford, John. Journal of an Embassy from the Governor General of India to the Courts of Siam and Cochin-china, Exhibiting a View of the Actual State of Those Kingdoms. 2nd ed. London, Colburn and Bentley, 1830. Pp. 459.

Discusses: Geography, people, government, economy, and social conditions.

The careers of two officials who served during the first half of the 19th century. Based on Chinese language sources.

Includes a chronological list of Vietnamese kings. Use of the Chinese calendar is cited as significant evidence of their dependent relationship with China.

80. Faivre, Jean Paul. L'Expansion Française dans Pacifique de 1800 à 1842. Paris, Nouvelles Editions Latines, 1953. Pp. 550.

A basic survey of the period.

81. Finlayson, George. The Mission to Siam and Huê the Capital of Cochin-China in the Years 1821-2. London, John Murray, 1826. Pp. 425.

An account by a member of the Crawford Mission. Treats Cochin-China, 304-406.

82. Gaultier, Marcel. Gia Long. Saigon, Ardin, 1933. Pp. 236, bibl.

An account of the political and military life of the Emperor, with a preface by Pierre Pasquier.

83. Gaultier, Marcel. Minh Mạng. Paris, Larose, 1935. Pp. 305.

A study of the life and rule of the Emperor, successor to Gia Long.

84. Lemonier, (Lt. Col.). "L'Éducation Militaire de Gia Long." Revue des Troupes Coloniales, 28(1934), 561-600.

Emphasis is placed upon the introduction of western concepts and techniques.
