Mr. Nguyen Quang Quynh

Mr. Nguyen Quang Quynh attended the University of Hanoi and received his License in Law from this University. In addition, he completed two parts of the requirements for a Doctorate in Law. He has had five years experience as a judge following two years in private practice as a lawyer.

Since 1955 he has been associated with the National Institute of Administration, first as a half-time professor and later as a full-time professor. The Institute, as an agency of the national government of Vietnam, concentrates its efforts on the improvement of governmental administration through a three year pre-entry degree program, an evening school, research and an in-service training program.

In 1957 he received the United Nations Technical Assistance Fellowship to observe the social welfare programs in France. In addition, he has been Secretary General of the Ministry of Social Action in Vietnam from 1955-57.

Mr. Quynh has been an active member of the Alumni Association of the Faculty of Law and of the Association for Administrative Studies. He has written many articles published in the journals of these organizations.

During the six months that Mr. Quynh will be in the United States, it is hoped that he will have the opportunity to visit social science research agencies and also social welfare agencies.

Mr. Quynh is 37 years old and the father of three children. He is particularly interested in the handling of juvenile delinquency in the United States. During his stay on the campus in East Lansing he has attended a course in research methods and criminology.
