Dear Miss Cunningham:


This Office received from Western Reserve University the transcript of record of Miss Tran Thi Kim Sa for the winter session 1958-1959. It appears from this transcript that she earned 10 units of credits. As you mentioned in your letter addressed to former Registrar Guerrero (now Dean of Student Affairs) dated June 5, 1959, that she had earned 17 units at the said University, we presume that the 7 units are not included yet in this transcript that we received. In your July 10 letter, you stated that she is at present taking 2 units of "Introduction to Library Materials" and 4 units of "Beginning Spanish" at the University of Wisconsin. The equivalent of the latter course in the University of the Philippines is only 3 units. Summarizing, the total number of units that Miss Kim Sa would have after finishing summer courses at the University of Wisconsin, would be 51 units which would be credited towards the Bachelor of Arts degree:

Taken at the College of Agriculture, U.P.	-	29	units
Taken at the Western Reserve University	-	17	"
Taken at the University of Wisconsin	-	5	"
T o t a l	- - - - -	51	

The total number of units required for an A.B. degree is at least 120 and the student's academic load is 30 units for the academic year. You can estimate, therefore, that if Miss Kim Sa will work for an A.B. degree, she will need 69 units more; it will take her about two academic years (including Summer sessions) to finish the degree. However, if your plan is just to let her take as many purely library science courses as possible, then you may just let her stay here for one year but without working for degree.

Enclosed please find a copy of a student's application blank and a copy of our revised academic calendar. You will note in the enclosed calendar that the registration for the second semester will be on November 9 through November 12, 1959; classes begin on November 16. If you decide to let her start in the second semester, it would be necessary for her to arrive in the Philippines before November 9, 1959.
