Born in 1929, in Quang Ngai province where my father was a schoolmaster, I spent my childhood and attended the primary school there. Toward 1939, I moved to Hue with my parents and 3 elder brothers. There after being graduated from a primary school in 1940, I was sent to the Khai Dinh High School where I studied among other things, French, English and Latin with French professors, till the end of 1944 when I came to Saigon to rejoin my eldest brother who worked as a civil servant there, and continued my study at the Petrus Ky High School. After my eldest brother had been killed by bombs dropped from

American planes in June 1945, my second brother and I who had narrowly escaped the former's fate returned to Hue. As soon as we arrived, the so called revolution of August 1945 broke out after the Japanese surrender. As I prepared myself to rejoin Khai Dinh School, French troops began landing on South VN the provinces of which fell one by one into their hands. Realizing that the resistance movement led by the communists could not be relied upon, my few friends and I left school to join the nationalist centers of resistance in North VN (Vinh, Vietri, Yenbay...) where we received military, political, and technical training from revolutionaries returning from China and Japan. A few months after the March 6th Agreement, assaulted by the French returning from China, harassed and besieged by the VM, we ~~xxx~~ resisted with all our forces, but were finally defeated. Many fled to China quite a few were killed or injured, the rest taken prisoners. I had the same fate as the latter at the battlefield of Vietri. Liberated after a few months of torture and ill-treatment in VM jails, I returned to Hue at the end of 1946 when the December 19th conflict between French and VM troops broke out.

After being evacuated in the country for some months, I was back in Hue early in 1947 and cooperated with several friends to found the Song Moi newspaper to continue our struggle for national independence. In 1948, as our journal was forced to cease its activities by a decree of French authorities I was obliged to earn my living as a radio operator at Radio Hue where I used to catch news in French and English from various international news agencies (AFP, UP...). Being an unique operator, I was overworked after 8 months and must resign to preserve my health. Late in 1949, I entered the Information Service in Central VN as operator and editor again. By dint of listening to the news, my head was troubled, and I was transferred at my request to the Economic Division in Central VN where I dealt with imports, exports, internal and external commerce. While working there, I attended the Khai Dinh school again as a free auditor and got my baccalaureate's degree.

Early in 1954, being admitted to the National Institute of Administration, I brought my little family to Dalat and in 1955 to Saigon. During 3 whole years of hard work, we learn almost all the subjects relating to economic financial administrative and juridical matters. In the military field, we completed the officer's course and a 6 month probationary period as a 2nd lieutenant in the army. I have chosen the Economic section and was graduated in January 1957. Since 1954, I have taken advantage of my spare time to study at the Law Faculty in Saigon and have now completed the 2nd year.

Now I have begun to work as chief of bureau dealing with economic and administrative affairs at the office of the Gia Dinh province chief. But I am eager to study again, to finish the Licentiate of Law, and hope to get an opportunity to go over to the U.S.A. to major in Economics for a few years in order, at my return, to serve my country and government more effectively by choosing the career of professor which, according to my opinion, would fit me best.
